

***"Assume that whatever you send down a drain at home or work will eventually end up in nearby water. Properly dispose of all household hazardous waste at a designated collection facility. Never dump anything on the ground, especially old pesticides, gasoline, motor oil, automotive fluids, and other consumer chemical products."**

This is a simple tip that makes a difference. Take shorter showers and buy a low-flow showerhead. Heating hot water for a 10 minute shower can generate 4 pounds of CO₂. Target taking your showers for 5 minutes or less. You can reduce your carbon emissions by 300 pounds per year.
