

COVER YOUR FACE SAVE. LIVES.



All persons over the age of two are required to wear a face covering when:

- Working in or patronizing businesses and operations that are open to the public.
- Engaging in essential activities such as shopping for necessary supplies and services, seeking medical supplies or medication, visiting a health care professional.
- Riding in public transportation, taxis, or ride share vehicles.

Persons DON'T need to wear a face covering when:

- Engaging in permissible outdoor physical activity such as walking, hiking, running or biking, while at the same time practicing social distancing.
- When riding in a personal vehicle.
- When a person is alone or with members of the same household or residence in a private space that is not open to the general public.
